

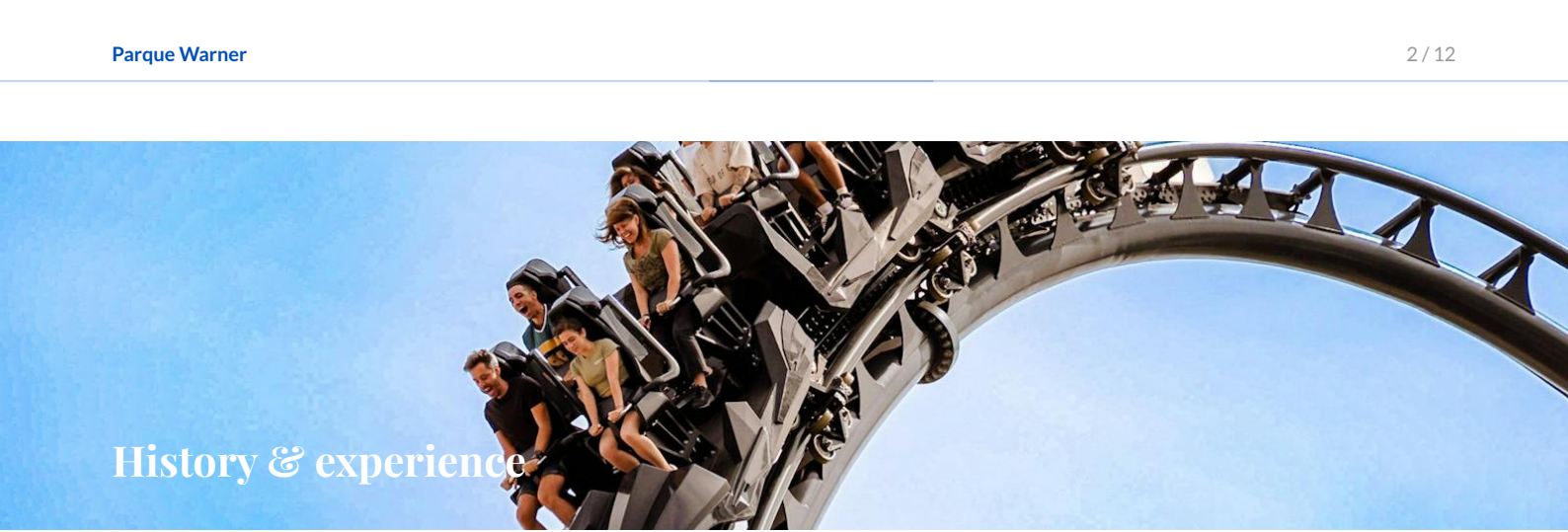

From Hollywood Dreams to Spanish Reality

Parque Warner Madrid was born from a bold vision to bring the magic of cinema to the heart of Spain. The park officially opened on **April 5, 2002**, in the presence of ten thousand guests and Hollywood stars like Bo Derek and Christophe Lambert. This grand inauguration marked the beginning of a new era for theme parks in Europe, promising an immersive journey through iconic movie scenes. The public access started the very next day, immediately attracting thousands of eager visitors from across the region.

The early years were not without challenges. Initially managed by Six Flags under a long-term contract, the park faced significant financial difficulties and operational issues. In November 2004, the Community of Madrid took control to stabilize the business and promote tourism in the southern zone. This strategic shift proved successful, leading to increased visitor satisfaction and profitability within the first season under new management.

In 2006, the park was rebranded as Parque Warner Madrid, reflecting its local identity and renewed focus. By 2007, Parques Reunidos, one of the world's leading theme park operators, took over management. This partnership brought international expertise and investment, further enhancing the park's attractions and services. The collaboration ensured that the park remained competitive and appealing to both families and thrill-seekers.

A major milestone was reached on August 7, 2010, when the park welcomed its **10 millionth visitor**. This achievement confirmed its lasting appeal and solidified its status as a must-visit destination in Spain. More recently, in May 2023, the park inaugurated Batman Gotham City Escape, its first major new roller coaster since opening. This modern addition has revitalized the park, offering a fresh breath of life and exciting new experiences for all generations.

THE EXPERIENCE

Stepping into Parque Warner Madrid feels like crossing the threshold into a living movie set. The entrance is dominated by the vibrant architecture of **Hollywood Boulevard**, where neon lights and classic facades instantly transport you to the golden age of cinema. The air is filled with the promise of adventure, as you see towering statues of beloved characters and detailed replicas of famous film locations. It is a sensory awakening that prepares you for a day of pure entertainment.

As you move deeper into the park, the atmosphere shifts with each themed zone. From the high-energy DC Super Heroes World to the whimsical Cartoon Village, every corner offers a unique visual feast. The lighting changes with the time of day, casting dramatic shadows in the afternoon and glowing warmly at night. This dynamic environment ensures that no two visits are exactly alike, keeping the experience fresh and engaging for repeat visitors.

ADDRESS

San Martín de la Vega · Access: A-4 exit 22 or Cercanías train to Pinto then direct bus. Allow 30-45 min from central Madrid.

OPENING HOURS

Generally 11:30 AM to 8:00 PM in high season, but varies by season and day. Be sure to check the 'Prepara tu visita' page on the official site.

FARES

Prices vary by date and ticket type. Buy online to guarantee access and potentially save compared to the box office.

VISIT DURATION

Allow a minimum of 5 hours to enjoy the main attractions like Batman Gotham City Escape. More if you want to see all the shows and explore the five themed zones

ORGANIZATION

Navigating the Five Themed Zones

Hollywood Boulevard (Entrance Zone)

This is the main entrance area, designed to evoke the glamour of classic Hollywood. You will find photo opportunities with iconic movie props and sets. The zone serves as the starting point for your journey, with clear signage directing you to other areas. It is ideal for taking initial group photos and grabbing a map.

DC Super Heroes World & Movie World Studios

These central zones house the most intense thrills, including Batman Gotham City Escape and Superman: La Atracción de Acero. The architecture here features futuristic designs and dark, atmospheric lighting. You will also find the Movie World Studios, which showcases various film sets and offers a behind-the-scenes look at filmmaking. This area is best visited in the morning to minimize wait times.

Cartoon Village & Old West Territory

These zones offer a mix of family-friendly fun and western-themed adventures. Cartoon Village is home to Looney Tunes characters and gentle rides suitable for children. Old West Territory features wooden coasters and interactive shows that appeal to all ages. The layout allows for easy walking between these two areas, making them perfect for mid-day exploration or a relaxed afternoon.

Must-Ride Attractions and Iconic Zones

01

DC Super Heroes World

Batman Gotham City Escape

This is the park's newest and most thrilling attraction, launched in 2023. It is a high-speed launched roller coaster that takes you through the dark streets of Gotham. The ride features intense inversions and sudden drops that will leave you breathless. It is considered a must-do for any adrenaline junkie visiting the park.

💡 It was the first major new roller coaster added to the park since its opening, marking a significant upgrade to the DC Super Heroes World zone.

02

DC Super Heroes World

Superman: La Atracción de Acero

Riding in the back of a suspended vehicle, you fly alongside Superman as he saves Metropolis. The view across the park is stunning, especially during the evening hours. The combination of speed and aerial perspective makes it one of the most memorable experiences. It is highly recommended to ride this attraction early in the day to avoid long queues.

💡 The ride offers a unique vantage point of the entire park, allowing you to see the layout of all five zones from above.

03

Movie World Studios

Stunt Fall

This giant inverted boomerang coaster delivers a series of unexpected flips and turns. The name 'Stunt Fall' reflects the unpredictable nature of the ride, which keeps riders on their toes. It is a great choice for those who enjoy moderate thrills without the extreme intensity of the Batman coaster. The queue line moves relatively quickly, making it a good option for filling gaps in your schedule.

💡 The ride is located near the lake, providing a scenic backdrop for photos taken before or after the ride.

04

Old West Territory

Coaster-Express

One of the oldest wooden coasters in the park, Coaster-Express offers a classic riding experience. The track twists and turns through the western-themed landscape, evoking the spirit of old-time rodeos. It is less intense than the steel coasters but still provides a fun and nostalgic ride. Families often enjoy this attraction because it is accessible to a wider range of ages.

💡 The coaster was part of the original lineup when the park opened in **2002**, making it a veteran of the park's history.

Cartoon Village

La Aventura de Scooby-Doo

This interactive dark ride allows visitors to join Scooby-Doo and his friends in solving mysteries. The ride features animatronics and sound effects that create an immersive spooky atmosphere. It is particularly popular with children and fans of the franchise. The interactivity adds an element of engagement that makes the ride feel personal and unique for each group.

💡 The ride system was updated in recent years to improve the smoothness of the track and enhance the visual effects.

Cartoon Village

Rápidos ACME

This rapids ride sends you down a winding river in a raft, splashing through waterfalls and narrow channels. It is a refreshing way to cool off on hot days, especially in summer. The ride is designed to be fun for all ages, with a mix of gentle sections and sudden drops. It is located in the Cartoon Village, making it easy to combine with other family-friendly attractions.

💡 The ride uses water from the park's large lake, ensuring a continuous flow throughout the operating season.

Movie World Studios

Hotel Embrujado

Also known as Mad House, this haunted house attraction takes you through a series of eerie rooms filled with ghosts and monsters. It is designed to scare even the bravest visitors, with jump scares and realistic props. The atmosphere is carefully crafted to build tension as you move deeper into the hotel. It is a great option for groups of friends looking for a shared thrill.

💡 The attraction is updated annually with new scenes and effects to keep the experience fresh for repeat visitors.

DC Super Heroes World

Shadows of Arkham

This inverted roller coaster offers a different perspective on the DC universe, with your legs dangling freely. The ride features several inversions and tight turns that test your nerve. It is a popular choice for those who want a thrill without the full intensity of the launched coasters. The queue line is often shorter than for the headline attractions, making it a smart strategy for maximizing your day.

💡 The ride was constructed by Bolliger & Mabillard, a renowned manufacturer of high-quality roller coasters.

TIPS

Smart Tips for a Perfect Day

TIMING

Arrive at least 30 minutes before opening to secure a spot in the fast-track lines for Batman Gotham City Escape and Superman. The first two hours are the calmest, allowing you to tackle the headline attractions before crowds build up.

BILLET

Always buy tickets online in advance. Online prices are often lower than box office rates, and pre-purchasing guarantees entry even if the park reaches capacity. Check availability for your specific date, as slots can be limited during peak seasons.

PARCOURS

Start your day in DC Super Heroes World, then move to Cartoon Village, and finish in Old West Territory. This route minimizes backtracking and allows you to cover the main attractions in one coherent loop. Use the official app to check real-time wait times and adjust your plan accordingly.

PHOTO

Set aside time for photos in front of the Hollywood Boulevard and Movie World Studios sets. These areas offer the best backdrops, especially late in the day when the lighting is warm and flattering. Bring a camera with a zoom lens to capture details of the elaborate sets.

PAUSE

Take a break in the afternoon around 2 PM to avoid the peak heat and crowds. There are several restaurants in the park, but you can also eat at local spots in San Martín de la Vega if you prefer cheaper options. Hydrate regularly, as the park is large and involves a lot of walking.

ENFANTS

Consult the official Height Guide before your visit to know which attractions are accessible to your children. Cartoon Village is dedicated to younger kids, so spend more time there if you have small children. Keep an eye on the app for show schedules to ensure you don't miss any family-friendly performances.

AUDIOGUIDE

While not strictly necessary for the rides, using the official app is essential for checking wait times and show schedules. It helps you adapt your day to current conditions and ensures you don't miss the live evening shows. The app is free to download and use.

CONFORT

Wear comfortable shoes, as you will be walking a lot across the 150 hectares of the park. Bring sunscreen, a hat, and a light jacket for the evening, as temperatures can drop after sunset. Lockers are available in the park for storing personal items securely.

FAQ

Where to buy tickets for Parque Warner Madrid?

Book online via the official site or authorized resellers to guarantee your access and avoid queues at the entrance. Online purchase often allows you to benefit from lower prices. Always check availability for your desire.

Are tickets valid for a specific date?

Yes, tickets are generally dated and cannot be rescheduled. It is essential to check availability online before purchasing, as slots may be limited during peak dates. Carefully choose your visit date.

Are there discounts for children?

Yes, reduced rates exist for children depending on their age or height. Conditions vary by attraction and must be consulted in the park's official height guide. Check this information on the official site before booking.

Can I cancel or modify my booking?

Cancellation terms depend on the ticket type and provider. Some tickets are non-refundable while others offer flexibility. Carefully review the terms and conditions when purchasing online to know your rights.

How much time should I allow to visit Parque Warner?

Allow at least 5 hours to enjoy the main attractions like Batman Gotham City Escape and Superman. If you want to see all the shows and explore the five zones, plan for a full day. Arrive at opening to minimize queues.

The Six Flags Era

Before the Community of Madrid took control, the park was managed by Six Flags under a 99-year contract. This period was marked by financial struggles and operational issues, leading to a decline in visitor numbers. The takeover in 2004 was a turning point, as the new management focused on improving quality and promoting tourism in the region.

A Decade of Growth

The park celebrated its 10 millionth visitor in 2010, a testament to its enduring popularity. This milestone highlighted the park's success in attracting both local families and international tourists. The growth was driven by consistent improvements in attractions and marketing efforts that emphasized the park's unique cinematic theme.

New Thrills in 2023

The introduction of Batman Gotham City Escape in May 2023 was a major event for the park. It was the first significant new roller coaster since the park's opening, signaling a commitment to innovation and expansion. The ride has been well-received by visitors and critics alike, boosting attendance in the following months.

Five Zones, One Experience

The park is divided into five distinct zones, each inspired by different Warner Bros films. This thematic approach creates a cohesive narrative that guides visitors through the park. From the glamour of Hollywood Boulevard to the chaos of DC Super Heroes World, each zone offers a unique atmosphere and set of attractions.

AROUND THE MUSEUM

Located in San Martín de la Vega, the park is surrounded by convenient amenities for visitors. Just outside the gates, you can find local restaurants in **San Martín de la Vega** offering affordable lunch options compared to park dining. For those who prefer a lighter meal, nearby shopping centers provide quick access to water and snacks before entering. Nature lovers can enjoy a relaxing walk in the **Vega Natural Park**, a green space close to the park that offers a peaceful contrast to the high-energy rides. If you have extra time, the small San Martín Municipal Museum provides a glimpse into the local history of the municipality, adding cultural depth to your day trip from Madrid.
